Talk On The Street

The festival season is upon us and there is a great line up for this summer in the downtown area. The Decatur Farmers Market has already completed their second week and the Downtown Weekly Concert Series on the Madison Street Plaza will begin June 5. The Decatur Sculpture Tour will be held on Saturday, June 14 with the Decatur Main Street DOWNTOWN DECATUR DAY the next weekend. The action will continue through July and August with a number of new promotions being planned by Main Street as well as returning ones. These all will make Downtown Decatur the place to be this summer.

We will be experiencing a slight damper on the traffic flow downtown throughout the summer, as the construction of the Five Points intersection will be taking place. The construction is set to begin June 1st and should be completed by the end of September. During this time the city will not allow either First or Third Streets to be closed, they will be used as the alternate routes for traffic. Once the project is completed it will create a fresh and inviting south entrance to the downtown area.

On another note our board is continuing to work on getting our Indiana Accredited Main Street designation completed. We have a tentative meeting planned with the state representatives for later in June. As mentioned in the last newsletter, Indiana Main Street, which is a department within the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs (OCRA) is going through a number of changes with budget cuts and new personnel. I have talked to our liaisons for Northeast Indiana numerous times and she assures me that they are committed to help us in every way to complete our accreditation.
