

The Talk on the Street

Over the last few months we have been continuing our work to become an accredited Indiana Main Street. A number of things on how we currently operate will be changing in order to fully align with us attaining the accreditation status.

One item that Indiana Main Street require is that we change from a membership driven organization to an organization supported by donations, this means that we will be adopting Supporter Levels for donations instead of membership dues. A plan is currently in review and details will be released soon.

Another change, although it is not required, but is highly recommended by the state is that we hire a full time Main Street Director who will concentrate on Main Street and our mission for at least 40 hours per week. This is a big expense that would truly explode our current budget to three times its current level. You may be asking, "How will we do this?"


The good news is that it is already done. We have been working with the city and the Decatur Redevelopment Commission and they both have agreed to become two our biggest monetary supporters and with their we will be able to increase our 2026 budget and cover the salary of a full time director.

Additional change are also coming and we will be announcing them once we get all the details in place. Hopefully we will have it all put together by the first of the year.

In other news we have formed a new sub committee that will concentrate on organizing our Christmas Open House in November and also will be putting together a promotional flyer for all things happening in the downtown area during November and December.
